2024 BUDGET MESSAGE

North Vista Highlands Metropolitan Districts Nos. 1-5 are quasi-municipal corporations organized and operated pursuant to provisions set forth in the Colorado Special District Act and were formed in 2018. The Districts are located in the City of Pueblo, Colorado and have a service area of approximately 1,054.49 acres. The Districts were organized to plan for, design, acquire, construct, install, relocate, redevelop, provide and finance public improvements and related operation and maintenance services within the boundaries of the Districts.

The Districts have no employees at this time and all operations and administrative functions are contracted.

The budgets are prepared on the modified accrual basis of accounting, which is consistent with the basis of accounting used in presenting the Districts' financial statements.

District 1

General Fund

Revenue

Budgeted income in the amount of \$25,642 primarily consists of operating advances and intergovernmental revenue.

Expenses

The District No. 1 2024 general and administrative expenses budgeted amount is \$18,200. Refer to the General Fund summary included with the budget.

Fund Balance/Reserves

As required by the TABOR amendment to the Colorado Constitution, the District has provided for an Emergency Reserve in the amount of 3% of the total fiscal year expenditures in the General Fund.

Capital Projects Fund

No revenue or expenses are expected for 2024.

Budgeted income in the amount of \$64,819 primarily consists of advances per the Funding Agreement and property taxes.

Expenses

The District No. 3 2024 general and administrative expenses budgeted amount is \$66,254. Refer to the General Fund summary included with the budget.

As required by the TABOR amendment to the Colorado Constitution, the District has provided for an

Emergency Reserve in the amount of 3% of the total fiscal year expenditures in the General Fund.

Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as Docusign or Echosign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,
- a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, or
- b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as Docusign or Echosign in accordance with the requirements noted above.
